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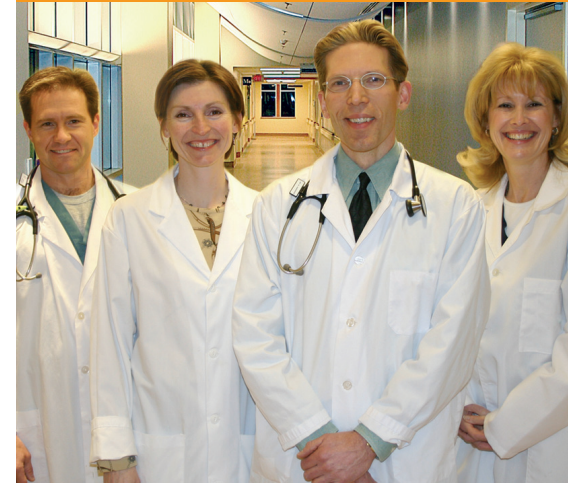

Thunder Bay Regional Health Sciences Centre is the tertiary or acute care centre to Northwestern Ontario capturing a regional referral area of approximately 250,000 people, covering a geographical area the size of France. Our local and immediate surrounding municipalities have a population base of approximately 125,000 people. We are also the regional trauma and stroke centre for Northwestern Ontario.

An architectural showpiece, the Regional Health Sciences Centre is a stunning award-winning design that is functionally efficient. As a centre for

research and education, TBRHSC utilizes leading-edge technology and hosts students from Canada's newest Medical School.

Our new-state-of-the-art facility has a Picture Archival Computer Systems (PACS) to record diagnostic images and offers tele-medicine, tele-stroke, tele-radiology and tele-education capabilities. In addition, the ability to store and move the data of a patient from an Electronic Medical Record makes the region's hospitals of Northwestern Ontario a virtual library whereby physicians and "need to know" care providers can assist with patient care in an instant. Family Practitioners have access and referral to every subspecialty service with the exception of Cardiac Surgery, however, there is a visiting specialist program to meet the cardiac surgical needs of this community.
